



Crépuscule

Pinot Noir 2021

Elgin is the coolest wine region in South Africa. This cool climate allows for the perfect ripening of grapes, creating wines that have freshness, flavour and balance. Crépuscule means twilight and is the delicate example of these unique characters.

Vineyards

Made from a single vineyard situated 300 metres above sea level and caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested, chilled and 30% was gently whole bunched pressed. They underwent a 3 day maceration before spontaneous fermentation began. Malolactic proceeded in barrels and the wine was left to mature using 30% New French oak barrels for a period of 11 months.

Tasting Notes

Very light ruby with a brick-red rim. Cola tonic and raspberry nose. Red fruits on a very light palate. Delicate and integrated. Drinks beautifully now and will further improve with cellaring

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Clergerie Blend 2023



Clergerie is a vinous exploration of the Cape South Coast area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested, chilled and gently whole bunched pressed. All the components were first blended and then fermented together in 4th and 5th fill french oak barrels. No enzymes or yeasts were added to allow spontaneous fermentation to happen. The wine was allowed to mature for 8 months.

Tasting Notes

Light gold in colour with some sunset nuance. The nose is intense, somehow exotic, with aromas of quince ,oatmeal and salty lemons. The palate is rich and driven by great balance and a lingering finish.

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Cabriole

S.Blanc 2023

Cabriole is a vinous exploration of the Bot-River area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

Situated on the southerly slopes, our parcels are exposed to the cool sea breezes ensuring slow and extended grape ripening. The sandstone soils induce low to moderate vigour which results in low yields but flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested, chilled and gently whole bunched pressed. The juice was settled for 10 hours, then racked and fermented partially using stainless steel tanks and 4 and 5 year old French oak barrels. The wine was blended together after 8 months, lightly filtered and bottled.

Tasting Notes

Signature lime, granadilla and gooseberry aromas are prominent.. The palate is vibrant yet textured, layered with yellow fruits, leading towards a saline character. The finish is long, somehow still refreshing.

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Carmelite Blend 2022



Carmelite is a vinous exploration of the Bot-River area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were handpicked and. They were intimately mixed together and transferred to open vessels, 50% crushed, 40% destemmed where they fermented naturally for a few days . After pressing the wine was then transferred to 300 L French oak barrels, 15 % new, and was allowed to mature for 9 months before bottling.

Tasting Notes

Bright red in colour. Delicate aromas of strawberries, cherries, pomegranate. An explosion of red fruits in the mouth ,with some earthy notes supported by soft tanins. Will gain tremendous complexity with time in the bottle.

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Charismatique Blend 2021



Charismatique is a vinous exploration of the Bot-River area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

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Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were handpicked and left overnight to cool down in a refrigerated container. They were intimately mixed together and transferred to open vessels, 50% crushed, 30% destemmed where they fermented naturally for a few days. After pressing the wine was then transferred to 300 L French oak barrels, 20 % new, and was allowed to mature for 16 months before bottling.

Tasting Notes

Delicate aroma with complex notes of peper, liquorice and black cherries. The palate entry is fresh with lavender but also dark berry fruit. The finish is dry with well distributed and elegant tannins.

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Callipyge Chardonnay 2020

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Vineyards

Made from a single vineyard situated 300 metres above sea level and caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested, chilled and gently whole bunched pressed. No enzymes or yeasts were added to allow spontaneous fermentation to happen. Only 30% was allowed to go through malolactic fermentation and the wine was matured in French oak barrels for 9 months, using 25% new.

Tasting Notes

Light gold in colour. Callipyge has aromas of developed and stewed fruit on the nose. Candy and lime are prominent on the full and rich palate. Lengthy, but delicate on the finish with great elegance.

Confession is a vinous exploration of the Bot-River area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were handpicked and moved to our cool room overnight. 40% was left whole bunch and the grapes were left soaking for 4 days. Spontaneous fermentation happened in open-top tanks and the wine was matured for 10 months, using 30% new French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Light ruby. Rose and cherry with raspberry. Light bodied, crunchy and fresh with more bright red fruit on the palate. A grippy, saline and moreish finish. Lengthy and refined.

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Vineyards

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Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were handpicked and moved to our cool room overnight. 60% were destemmed and the balance left as whole bunch. Spontaneous fermentation happened in open-top tanks. This vintage was matured a little less time than the last, only 14 months using 20% new French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Amazing colour with a savoury bouquet. Black olive, spicy fruit, violet and white pepper on the nose. Flavours of berry fruits with fine ripe tannins and freshness make this wine elegant and will ensure its longevity.

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L'Intemporelle Brut Nature 2020



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Vineyards

Made from a single vineyard situated 300 metres above sea level and caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

Grapes are hand-picked early in the morning to ensure optimal freshness. The bunches are pressed whole and only the cuvee is used to make the base wine. After the alcoholic fermentation, the wines are bottled and yeast introduced for a second fermentation. The bottles ferment and mature horizontally in a cool dark cellar for a minimum of 30 months. It is then riddled and disgorged. It is left for a further 30 days to mature on the cork to allow integration and balance.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of apples, pears, and hints of fresh ocean spray. On the palate, flavours of frangipane are supported by a crisp minerality. Tiny bubbles with an explosive entry and long dry finish.

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L'Impassible Brut 2020



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Vineyards

Made from a single vineyard situated 300 metres above sea level and caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

Grapes are hand-picked early in the morning to ensure optimal freshness. The bunches are pressed whole and only the cuvee is used to make the base wine. After the alcoholic fermentation, the wines are bottled and yeast introduced for a second fermentation. The bottles ferment and mature horizontally in a cool dark cellar for a minimum of 30 months. It is then riddled and disgorged and a light dosage is added. It is left for a further 30 days to mature on the cork to allow integration and balance.

Tasting Notes

Notes of honey and brioche supported by subtle hints of bruised apple, citrus and grapefruit. A soft bubble mousse, fresh and bright on the palate.

Seul Amour is a vinous exploration of the Bot-River area in the Cape South Coast, South Africa. Our winemaking philosophy is of minimal intervention to produce a unique terroir driven wine.

Vineyards

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

Our Seul Amour Sauvignon Blanc 2022 was whole bunch pressed and fermented wild in stainless steel tanks and left on its lees for seven months before bottling.

Tasting Notes

Prominent blackcurrant, and flint aromas with subtle notes of dried flowers and lemon grass. The palate is racy and fresh, with granadilla and oyster shell, leading towards a saline character. It is zippy and mouth watering.

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Vineyards

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested and carefully sorted. Fermentation took place in open vats and each cultivar was separately matured for 18 months in third and fourth filled French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Deep ruby red with a violet rim. Showing aromas of ripe currants, forest floor and tea leaf caressed by the spicy flavours of white pepper and coriander. Complex concentrated fruits, medium bodied with dense but silky tannins. Drink now but will further improve in the next 5 to 8 years.

These parcels are situated 120 m above sea level caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

The grapes were hand harvested and carefully sorted. Fermentation took place in open vats and each culti- var was separately matured for 14 months in third and fourth filled French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Dark fruited delight showing aromas of violets and exotic spices, all on a bed of fine tannins. Finishing with a fresh but lingering aftertaste. Svelte and sophisticated.
