

L'Impossible Brut 2022



Elgin is the coolest wine region in South Africa. This cool climate allows for the perfect ripening of grapes, creating wines that have freshness, flavour and balance.

Vineyards

Made from a single vineyard situated 300 metres above sea level and caressed by the cooling sea breezes from the Atlantic a few kilometres away. Rainwater is retained in the iron-rich clay and cobble soils which results in low yield and flavour concentration.

Winemaking & Maturation

8% of the base wine was fermented in seasoned French oak barrels, contributing subtle richness and layering. The remainder was vinified in stainless steel to capture varietal purity and freshness. The wine was left on lees for 31 months to build texture, depth, and a fine, persistent mousse. Disgorgement was followed by a carefully measured dosage, highlighting the wine's natural balance and structure.

Tasting Notes

The bouquet is elegant and focused, offering aromas of citrus blossom, red apple, crushed raspberry, and toasted brioche. On the palate, it is finely structured, with a delicate mousse and a crisp backbone of acidity. Notes of lemon zest and subtle almond lead to a long, mineral finish.
